| International Airfare - Canada to/from Scotland | <p>The cost of our private journeys are quoted without international air between Canada and Scotland.</p> <p>We do this because some guests may wish to use frequent flyer points to obtain their airline ticket or they may wish to use a different airline or a different routing from the rest of the group.</p> <p>The cost of an air ticket can vary widely depending on the actual dates of travel, your choice of airline and your choice of booking class.</p> <p>The least expensive fares are generally available to those who book early.</p> <p>TrailFinders' staff are experts in international air selection and we would be pleased to work with you on your international travel arrangements.</p> <p>If you choose to do your air yourself, please check with us prior to pushing the button.</p> | <p>Cost depends on your departure city, airline, travel dates, classes, seat availability and hub choice.</p> <p>Please call us for assistance.</p> |
| Travel Insurance | <p>Travel Insurance medical coverage is mandatory for all guests on our Private Journeys. If you already have your own insurance, you will be required to show proof of coverage.</p> <p>As well, we continue to highly recommend that each guest have adequate Trip Cancellation and Interruption insurance. Guests who choose not to purchase this coverage will be required to sign a waiver to that effect.</p> <p>In line with insurance company rules, all trip cancellation and interruption insurance premiums are payable <u>at time of deposit and booking</u>. Medical insurance premiums (if required) may be paid at the same time (in the case of a packaged insurance policy) or any time prior to departure if done as a separate policy. Premiums vary with the age of the insured and the duration of the trip. We can provide you with insurance recommendations and premiums to suit your individual situation. Our website includes our recommended link to insurance quotes from Manulife.</p> <p>Since foreign ground handlers, transport providers and hotel companies may or may not have adequate insurance coverage for serious injury or death of foreign travellers in case of accidents or local events, we highly recommend that you cover yourself for these eventualities by having a reputable Canadian insurance policy. | Water, drinks, laundry | <p>Drinking water is generally made available along the way, but we often find that we buy another large bottle of water every few days as well.</p> <p>Other drinks – Beer, scotch, gin, wine, fruit juices and soft drinks are more expensive than in Canada and we find that whatever a drink costs in “dollars” in Canada, it is likely going to cost the same amount in “pounds” in Scotland.</p> <p>Laundry - We travel light and we usually have the hotel do a little laundry about every five days. Quality is good. Of course, you may prefer to wash things yourself in places where they will have time to dry.</p> | <p>Approx. | Personal Tips | TrailFinders handles the tips for the group as described previously. But there may be times when you will be expected to tip someone who performs a personal service for you.
